THURSDAY			
Standard Sequence	Options	Comments	Notes
Reception		Director, Vice Director, Cha Cha’s, Song team, Clergy try to get acquainted a few minutes before going to reception.	Ask all Pilgrim’s Inn team members to go to the reception & mingle as soon as they can. Sometimes the Director and Vice Director spend time in prayer during this time.
Director’s Opening Talk			It is suggested that the Director spend some time at the reception to get relaxed before beginning the Walk.
“KNOW YOURSELF” Meditation			Clergy
“PRODIGAL SON” Meditation			Clergy
Way of the Cross		Cursillo-We are confronting them with the sin in their lives. Introducing Christian discipline. <u>Grace</u> - Silence/Reflection back to who we are and what God has done for us. Helps us understand that God’s Grace is given to us.	Have 3 or 4 Chas bring up cross and candles. Have 3 or 4 speakers/table disciples assigned to hold cross and candles after first station and then instruct team to hold back, allowing candidates to respond.

Team Meeting			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go over schedule • Share theme and what God has been doing in your life. • This may be the only time you will have an opportunity for quality time with all the team together. • Consecration of Team, Talks, Instruments, pots, pans, etc. • Ask Pilgrim’s Inn team to observe silence for the evening just as the candidates do. • Organization of communion & consecration is responsibility of KP Spiritual Director & Song Team.

This concludes the day with a reverent activity, much like the Way of the Cross on Thursday and Agape on Saturday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have the palanca team set this up to maintain a worshipful atmosphere. • Song team can help this to be a worship service by the type of songs they sing. • Director, Vice, Spiritual team, Chas wash feet. • First wash feet of Song team and Cha Chas. • Wash feet in table groups. • No lotion, powder or back rubs. <p>Candidates should not wash feet. This is a time for them to experience God’s grace and love to them.</p>
Team meeting		Often, Mañanitas song is practiced at this meeting to ensure people know it. If there will be no team meeting on Saturday night, describe which rooms will have to be vacated on Sunday morning and how that will be accomplished.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss the procedure for Closures on Sunday and ask all the team to help make the service a time of worship.

Fiesta			The director should instruct the Chas, Speakers and Table Disciples to keep the levity under control during this time and to be sensitive to others feelings.
DISCIPLESHIP Talk			
Agape		Kitchen & Palanca should leave Agape after the Pilgrim's Inn people have come in and seen them. Members of the Love team, Agape team, or community should not be in the Agape room.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be on time! The community is waiting. • Following the Agape service the Cha Chas should lead the Pilgrims to bed. • After Agape the background team should not be seen again until morning.

Cross Ceremony		Only team members who have been in the Pilgrim's Inn during the entire weekend should be at this service.	Background team members, Sponsors, or members of the community should not attend this ceremony.
Have the Secretariat Representative and the other team's director share briefly with the new Pilgrims		Make sure you find out who they are and notify them of when and where you will need them.	
	Sharing Time	This gives candidates a chance to think about how the weekend has affected them while still in the comfortable setting they have enjoyed all weekend.	
Closura Will start @ 3:30 PM.		Be very careful and sensitive to the candidates at this time. Don't force them or make them uneasy about getting up and sharing.	Be on time! The community is waiting.
